#### **New Resources for the English Curriculum**

In 2014 NSW Schools will be using the new English Curriculum. This updated curriculum brings the most recent innovations in teaching practice as well as including the increased use and importance of information technology. Students today read many different formats including digital formats and printed resources.

At SCPS we have ensured students have access to a variety of resources including digital books (also called e-books) and the printed version as well as websites and other types of media such as DVDs, and educational games. It is a very exciting time to be working in the library as students become more familiar with using digital resources.

We have been pleased to discover that there are many existing items in our collection which are included on the list of suggested quality resources for the new English Curriculum. We are currently expanding our collection with a particular focus on items that we are missing from the suggested quality resources list.

Part of this process has involved checking the list of items for each stage group to ensure we have the right resources to match student learning needs.

#### **Library Lessons Term 4**

Library lessons in term four are focussing on a variety of topics. Stage 2 and 3 students are practising their research skills with the topic of the Australian icon Uluru. Students will be practicing the Super Six comprehension strategies which are a fun way to improve comprehension skills. They are also learning the steps of the research process which can be used for any topic. Skills include note taking, using visual organisers, working in a team and choosing quality resources.

Kindergarten and Year 1 are currently exploring a variety of poetry, with the theme of Spring and Summer.

Once again, thank you for supporting students reading and the SCPS library.
