### DOG EDUCATOR VISITING K-2

On Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December, a team from the Responsible Pet Education Program of NSW will visit classes from Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2.

The presenter and her dog, will discuss issues about owning a pet and responsibilities such as playing with dogs, identification tags, yearly vaccinations and visiting the vet.

They will also highlight safety around animals including:

- the rules of what to do if you see or are approached by an *angry* dog
- what to do if you see a *scared* dog
- what to do if you see a *dangerous* dog
- happy dogs
- the times when you do not pat a dog, including your own
- not to be cruel to or tease a dog
- how to say hello to a dog safely.
