Please check your child's bag this week as I have put out a separate note regarding the Sporting Schools Program.



School Attendance

Just a reminder to all parents and caregivers that school attendance is compulsory.

If your child is sick for a period of more than two days it is a requirement that the school phone you in regards to your child's wellbeing. On their return to school a note must accompany them to explain their absence. If you are going on an extended holiday you must notify the school and fill out the necessary paperwork so that we know where your child/children are during their extended absence. If your child is away for an extended period due to sickness then a doctors Certificate will be required.

If a child has unsatisfactory attendance I am required to make an application to the Home School Liaison Program and local manager for their consideration of further action.

Flu Season!

Last year was a horrendous flu season for the staff and students at Surveyors Creek and this year looks like it is going to repeat itself. I would encourage all to have a flu shot as a preventative. I also ask you not to send your child to school if they are unwell or are presenting with flu like symptoms to minimise the spread.

Staff Car Park

No parents or students are permitted in the car park in the morning or afternoon unless you are dropping off or picking up your child from YMCA. For morning drop off between 7am- 8:15am and for afternoon pickup after 3:30pm.

If you have a disabled sticker we only have one parking spot at the top of our car park closest to the main school entry. If you are the disabled driver of the car and are collecting your children you will need to exit your car and escort your child to the disabled parking spot. **Please do not call them to the car.**

If you do have a disabled sticker but have an able bodied driver it would be appreciated if you use the Kiss n Drop to collect your child/children in the afternoon. Of course if you are the disabled person who needs to access our office please don't hesitate to use the allocated disabled parking spot. **All other community must use the main gate when entering and exiting our school.**

Kiss n Drop

Once again it has brought to my attention that some members of our community are acting in an unsafe manner when using the kiss n drop.



It is not okay to:

*Overtake on the crossing! *Abuse other parents! *Abuse Carl our crossing supervisor! *Double Park in the Kiss n Drop! *Hold up the flow of traffic in the Kiss n Drop!

*Park in the Kiss n Drop to wait for your child/children so that there is no room for others to collect their child/children!

Please Remember to:

Move down as far as you can.

Remind your children to come out straight from class and not linger in the playground if you are picking them up.

Adhere to the road rules and be careful and vigilant at all times.

If the Kiss n drop is full drive down to the roundabout at the bottom of the school then back up to the top one and continue to loop until you see your child and a vacant space becomes available.

Be courteous to others at all times.

When Carl is not on Crossing Duty we remind all public to adhere to the road rules and proceed with caution and safety!
