School Attendance



Just a reminder to all parents and caregivers that school attendance is compulsory.

If your child is sick for a period of more than two days it is requirement that the school phone you in regards to your child's wellbeing. On their return to school a note must accompanying them to explain their absence. If you are going on an extended holiday you must notify the school and fill out

the necessary paperwork so that we know where your child/children are during their extended absence. If your child is away for an extended period due to sickness then a doctor's certificate will be required.

If a child has unsatisfactory attendance I am required to make an application to the Home School Liaison Program and local manager for their consideration of further action.
