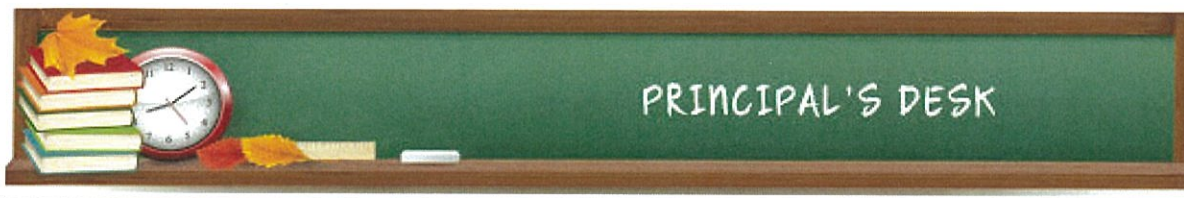

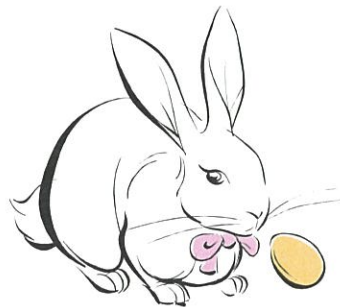
In Short - 3 certificates = a ribbon 3 ribbons = a banner
