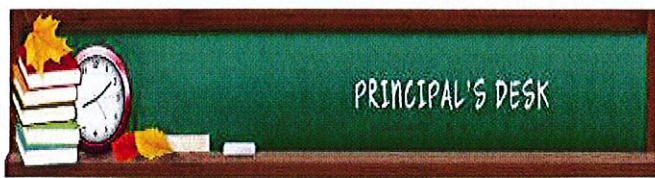
Please return permission/Medical slip and payment of \$44.00 to the grey box outside the administration office by 9am 30th November. If paying online please make payment by 6pm 29th November.

20th Anniversary Celebrations!!!!!!



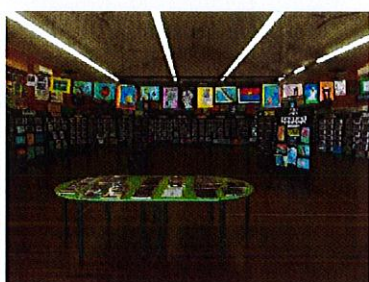
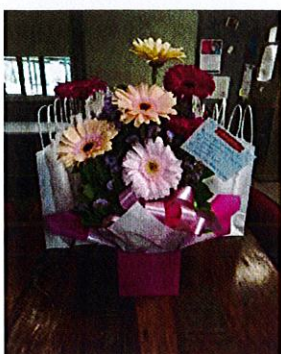
Wow....what a turnout! The sun was shining, and everyone was in a festive mood.

A fabulous effort from our debaters who took out this year's Grand final! Well done to Mrs Maiden for the amazing job she did coaching our amazing team!

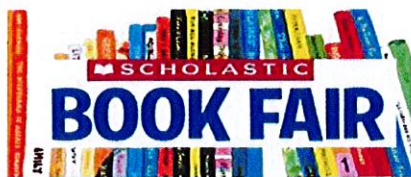
Public Speaking Final
