## PBL AWARD INITIATIVE



Dear Parents and Caregivers

As part of our PBL initiative students receive merit awards, school ribbons, banners and a medallion.

The system works as follows:

3 Merit awards = a school Ribbon

3 school Ribbons = a school Banner

3 school Banners = a school Medallion.

### **THERE IS NOW A CHANGE IN HOW STUDENTS APPLY FOR THE BANNERS AND MEDALLIONS!**

Once a student has collected three of the merit awards they can take them to the class teacher who will sign and date the back of the awards. The student will receive a school ribbon during the PBL assembly in week 5 or week 10.

\*\*\*To receive a school Banner, students will need to bring in the 9 awards and 3 ribbons for each banner being awarded.

\*\*\* To receive a school Medallion students will need to show 27 merit awards, 9 school Ribbons, 3 school Banners.

So that students names can be seen in the newsletter there is a due date for the awards to be received by the classroom teacher.

For the week 5 PBL assembly the awards must be received by the class teacher Monday week 4.

For the week 10 PBL assembly the awards must be received by the class teacher Monday week 9.

An easy way to keep track of school awards is to keep them in a display folder, these can be purchased from Office Works for less than \$2.
