****IMPORTANT****

Parents need to arrange transport for their child to and from the venue. One Parent-Spectator is able to enter the venue under the Covid-safe plan, and they must wear a wrist-band that we will provide. Spectators must sign in on the venues QR code and pay a \$3 entry fee on arrival with a cashless payment. Students may not use the shower facilities.

Students may be signed out by a parent at any-time or at 2:30pm (expected carnival finish time).

Uniform: Surveyors Creek Public School **sports uniform, towel, swimmers, goggles, sunscreen and hat**

Cost: **\$11.00 per child** (includes pool/carnival entry, pool hire levy). Payment is required prior to the carnival. Students will be loaned a school swim cap and they **MUST** wear this when competing.

Competitors successful in gaining nomination for the Sydney West Swimming Carnival must purchase, a P.S.S.A. swimming cap for **\$5** and a Penrith Zone P.S.S.A. T-shirt for **\$30**.

Lunches: Children should **bring a packed lunch**.

Wet Weather: Should it be raining the carnival will go ahead.
