- \*Overnight bags should be the size of a small pack or carry-on luggage as larger suitcases cannot be stored. All students will be required to carry their own bag!

#### **CAMP GUIDELINES:**

- Never leave camp area or activity areas without permission
- All activities are supervised by a supervising teacher
- Listen to and follow instructors' guidelines and instructions
- Closed in shoes and a hat must be worn at all times
- Respect male and female areas. Enter no room other than your own

<p><b>Day 1</b> Thursday 29<sup>th</sup></p>	<p>8am Students arrive at school. 8:30am Students will depart school via bus. Students arrive in Sydney:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students will attend a Sydney Walking tour – The story of Sydney. On the tour students will learn about the consequences of this arrival for both the indigenous and the newcomers. They will visit many iconic and historic landmarks that are uniquely Australian and see examples of how the Sydney foreshore has changed over time. Landmarks and heritage sites are explored through stories relating to important individuals and groups in society from this time.</li> <li>➤ Lunch at First Fleet Park.</li> <li>➤ Students will travel by private charter ferry to Cockatoo Island. All students will have an allocated seat on the ferry.</li> <li>➤ Arrive at Cockatoo Island.</li> </ul> <p>Students will be sleeping in pre-erected tents which will be ready to go and simply require students to bring their own sleeping bags and pillows. Each tent accommodates up to three students. Teachers will allocate students to tents – students will be given the chance to nominate students they would like to share with closer to the date.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Dinner will be provided to students. *If your child has any food allergies please complete the special dietary requirements note.</li> </ul> <p>Students will sleep over night in their tents. Teachers will continue to provide supervision throughout the evening and will be available to any students who need assistance during the night. Teachers will also be available to accompany students to the bathroom.</p>
<p><b>Day 2</b> Friday 30<sup>th</sup></p>	<p>8am Students up and ready for the day. All students pack up personal belongs and sleep bags. *Please ensure that your child can roll their sleeping bag up – some practice may be necessary!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students will be provided with breakfast.</li> <li>➤ Students will begin the educational tour of Cockatoo Island - Then, Now &amp; Tomorrow. They will participate in engaging character role-play from different periods of Cockatoo Island's history.</li> <li>➤ Students will be provided with lunch on the island.</li> <li>➤ Students will visit the Visitors Centre where they will work through educational activities.</li> </ul> <p>2:30pm Students picked up via Private Charter ferry. 4pm Arrive back at school.</p>
