## STAGE 3 GIRLS MEETING

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

I am writing to inform you that we will be running an information meeting with our Stage 3 girls on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> of February. The aim of this meeting is to brief our Stage 3 girls in regard to what to do if they begin, or have issues with, their periods at school. Some of the things we will cover are;

- Who to see if you get your period at school
- Where to go if you need a pad
- Appropriate places to dispose of pads at school
- Where in the office spare pads are located.

We ask that you have a discussion about this with your daughter prior to the meeting and answer any questions they may have. If you do not wish for your daughter to participate in this meeting, or if you have further queries, please contact the school to schedule a discussion with one of our Stage 3 teachers.

We are also asking that the girls with acrylic fingernails are kept at a reasonable length that does not interfere with a student's ability to play sport and complete written work.

We also request that earrings worn are suitable for school, preferably sleepers or studs that are safe for children to play during break times as well as during sporting activities.
