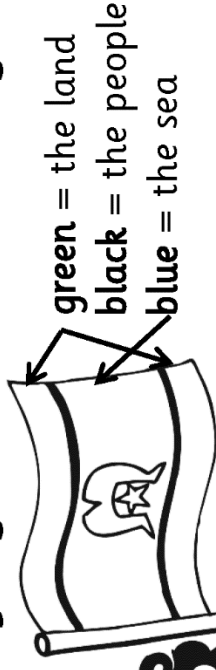


Indigenous Australian Flags

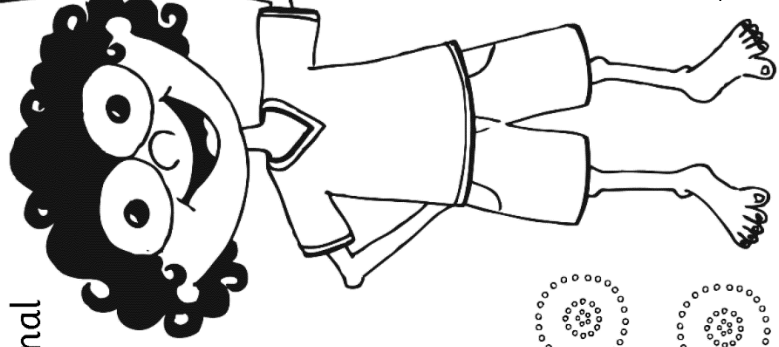
Flags have symbols within them that have a strong meaning for the group of people they represent. Each of the colours and shapes used in the flags has a meaning.



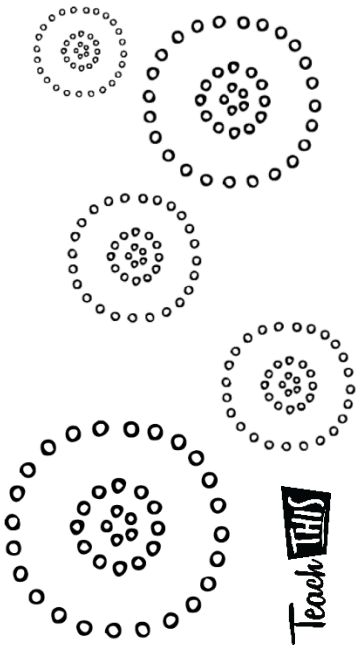
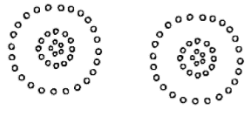
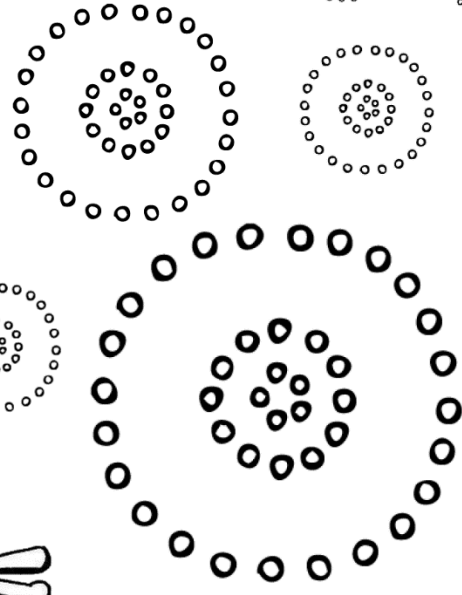
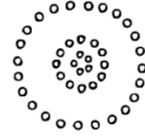
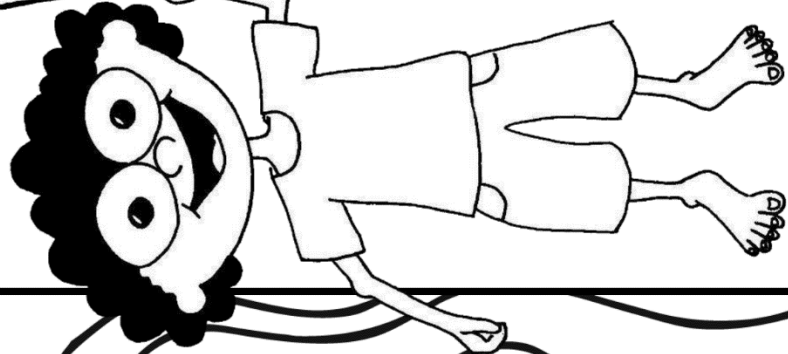
yellow = the sun

blue = the sea

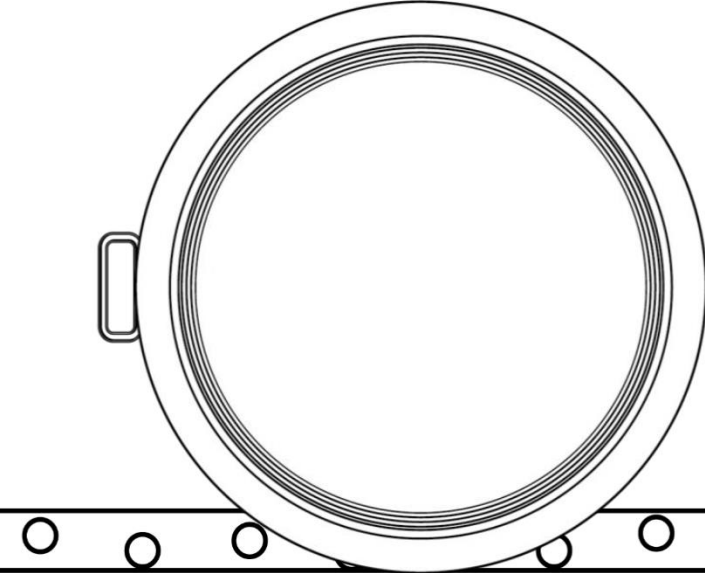


The white star is for peace and the island groups.
The white dhari is for the Torres Strait Islanders.

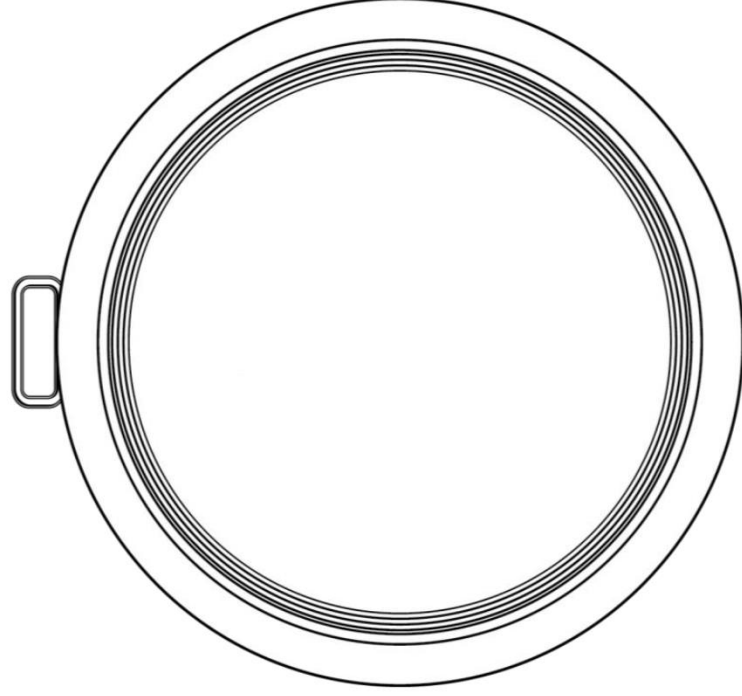
