Surveyors Creek Public School Intake area changes

Why is the Surveyors Creek Public School intake area being changed?

At times it is necessary for the department to make adjustments to a school's local enrolment area. This is happening to accommodate a new primary school in Mulgoa Rise Glenmore Park into our local network to ensure students continue to have access to high-quality public education.

How were the new intake areas determined?

The process was informed by demographic advice about projected enrolments in the Glenmore Park Primary network of schools and in consultation with local primary and secondary school Principals.

The new catchment areas can be found on the map overleaf and on the School Finder website at <u>schoolfinder.education.nsw.gov.au</u>

When will the change take place?

The intake area adjustment will apply for all new enrolments for K-6 for 2023. That is, students enrolling for the 2023 school year.

What if I now live in the intake area for the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise but I want to enrol my child in our previous local or other school?

The standard process will apply for requests for out-ofarea enrolments in accordance with the department's enrolment policy.

If this is the case, you should talk to the principal of your local school.

I have a child already attending Surveyors Creek Public School, can they stay there if I am now in the intake area for the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise?

Yes, they can. There is no change for students already attending Surveyors Creek Public School. They can complete their education at Surveyors Creek Public School. I have a child already attending Surveyors Creek Public School, can they move schools to the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise if we live in the intake area for the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise?

Yes, they can. If you live in the intake area for the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise you can apply to enrol your child at the new primary school in Mulgoa Rise.

We were in the local intake area when my child was enrolled at Surveyors Creek Public School. The intake area change means that our residence is now out-of-area. I have other children and I want them all to go to the same school. What are my options?

At times it is necessary for the department to make adjustments to a school's local enrolment intake area. This could mean a family with a child/children already enrolled in a school is then outside the local intake area. When this happens, the family will still be able to enrol siblings together at Surveyors Creek Public School.

My circumstances are challenging and I think this school is best for my child. We live outside the school's intake area. What should I do?

We understand that not everyone's circumstances are the same, and that there are instances where exceptional and compelling circumstances will need to be considered.

If this is the case, you should talk to the principal of your local school.
